

FRENCH LANGUAGE EXAM FOR DELF (INTERMEDIATE) AND DALF (ADVANCED)

DELF for intermediate and DALF for advanced are on the list of BACCALAUREATE equivalent exams!

The French language courses aim to prepare participants to get certified in the intermediate and advanced competence levels.

WHY ARE THESE CERTIFICATES THE BEST CHOICE FOR YOU?

The DELF and DALF certification diplomas enjoy a great international recognition and correspond to the level B1-B2 on the scale of Common European Framework of Reference for Languages, published by the Europe Council.

These diplomas, issues by the Ministry of Education in France, mainly target those individuals who wish to study in France or pursue a career improvement.

REGISTRATION: between September and July, at the Language Centre, *Spiru Haret* University, 13 Ion Ghica Str., district 3, Bucharest;

Documents required for registration (in the original):

- Identity card
- School documents (for the USH students/graduates, the gradebook or enrollment contract is sufficient)
- The receipt to prove payment (cashier's office at the registered USH office)
- The registration application form, filled out (DOWNLOAD)

DURATION: a module (*beginner, intermediate, advanced*) includes **6-30 hours** and runs for **4-10 weeks**, depending on the course type;

DAY AND TIME: this information is established during the first meeting with the teacher, for maximum attendance purposes. The classes can also be scheduled for the weekend;

CLASSROOM: at the registered office of *Spiru Haret* University;

GROUPS: small size;

COURSEBOOKS: Do not purchase the coursebooks prior taking the Placement Test and conferring with the teacher on which module is pertinent for you to go through!
